<u>Uniforms:</u> The Galileo School uniform consists of a polo shirt (K-8) t-shirt (6-8) with the Galileo School logo <u>from Lands' End</u>. Our preferred school number: 900148123. Pants, skirts, shorts, or skorts must be khaki/tan-colored and in good repair. **Hair:** No bandannas may be worn. **Shoes:** Students must wear closed shoes at all times. Crocks, backless shoes, sandals, wheelies, open toed shoes and flip flops may not be worn. **Spirit Fridays:** Students may wear their Galileo Spirit shirts (club, sports and ptsa) with khaki or jeans, midthigh length or longer without holes. **Dresses/Jumpers:** Girls must wear shorts, leggings, or bloomers **under** their Galileo school logo dresses and jumpers.

School Lunch: Galileo in conjunction with USDA is providing all students with breakfast and lunch at no charge for the 2021-2022 school year. Whether you have a current school lunch account or not, we will offer all students free breakfast and lunch if they want it. No additional documentation or registration is needed. Any money in your lunch account will remain intact and be available to use after this program ends. This only applies to student lunches, not adult lunches or extra snacks offered in our cafeteria. This will continue through the end of the Spring semester. Parents can pay for extra snacks via check or credit card by visiting MySchoolAccount.com. *If your student(s) arrives late in the morning, please pack them a lunch from home or call the front office to place your order before 8:45. Unless students are purchasing extra food, they do not need to pay for their lunch.

Paying School Fees: All families are encouraged to create a schoolpay account (www.schoolpay.com) to pay for student fees. (Lunch is the only fee not payable on schoolpay).
