Due to the decline in COVID cases in recent weeks, SCPS has adjusted the mask policies and visitors' policy as noted below effective November 1st. Galileo will align with this policy change.

For those families who still want to send their children with masks, that is absolutely fine. As we iron out more details, I will keep you posted.

Dear SCPS Families and Staff,

I am pleased to announce that as a result of the current status of community transmission of COVID-19 cases within Seminole County, the SCPS Student Face Covering with "parental opt-out" and Campus Visitor Suspension procedures will not be extended beyond the October 29th expiration date. In an effort to afford principals and schools time to make any necessary adjustments and plan for these changes, the procedures will remain in place through October 29, 2021.

Additionally, the Employee, Vendors, and Contractors Face Covering procedures are suspended as of November 1, 2021.

Effective November 1, 2021, SCPS will move to a mask optional environment across the District. We continue to encourage care and caution as we strive to achieve normalcy in these unprecedented times. These have been challenging weeks as we have navigated the fluidity of the impact of the Delta variant, and we thank you for your support and cooperation throughout the process.
